A group of 18 Sugar Land Baptist Church members returned from Bastrop after spending the day helping clean up ash and debris left by the devastating wildfires. Over 1,600 homes were destroyed and efforts are being made to clean everything off the slab of homes, so homeowners can begin the rebuilding process.

Cindy F., homeowner of the first property we worked at, had purchased the home as a foreclosure and had it remodeled. The remodeling was completed one week before the wildfires. Everything was destroyed--only part of the chimney was left standing. Sadly, the home she was living in while this one was remodeled was also totally destroyed by the fires.

She visited after we had completed the clean-up and was so excited—she couldn't believe we had the slab completely cleared, all in one day!! To say she was grateful is an understatement!
